## **COSTA BLANCA MOUNTAIN WALKERS - WALK DESCRIPTION**


This whole circuit is shaped rather like a lollipop formed from a lopsided inverted triangle. Up to now you have been walking up the lollipop stick; now you're going to take the left hand branch of the inverted triangle, and later on you're going to return to this spot on the way down.	
So ignore the small wooden post pointing you straight ahead, and continue to bend round to the left, following the wall on the LHS, as you start up a cobbled path.	
After about 14 mins you reach a concrete road and turn right onto it. You stay on this concrete road only for a couple of minutes. It leads up past a house on your right, and round a left hand bend, to where you see a signpost on your right for a walking route s'Alzinaret. (point B) 16 mins.	36 mins 1 km
Take this path, looking at the start a little overgrown. You gradually realise you're walking up the lowest part of a small valley, and this is the general direction you want to take until you reach the road at the top. After about 6 mins where it looks as if there's a junction in the path, you take the left hand branch up, rather than the right branch (which goes level along a terrace).	
After another 6 minutes, as you're going up the floor of the valley, it looks as if the way ahead is blocked, but the path leads on a detour to the left, and just round the corner take the path up to the right.	
About 3 mins later you come again to the lowest point of the valley and cross it to a junction in the path (where an old disused car may still be). The major track leads round to the right, but you want to take the left hand fork, keeping a wall on your RHS. Immediately afterwards, continue straight ahead on the path marked with cairns, and pass through a green gate. The path continues quite steeply uphill on the shaded right hand bank of the little valley.	
About 7 mins later you come out into a clearing and you see a house ahead. You go up and pass to the right of the house, and the track becomes a surfaced road which leads you up to the main road (the Ma-10 again). (point C) 26 mins	1 hr 2 mins 1.8 km
Turn right and continue along the main road for about 30 metres, and take the track starting on the LHS of the road, going through a gate with warnings about big game hunting. You're now starting along the top of the triangle. Continue along this wide track as it wends upwards through the forest, until you come out from under the trees and reach a high point with a rocky outcrop on the RHS, onto which you can clamber to get some spectacular views. Good spot for a picnic! (point D) 22 mins	1 hr 24 mins 2.8 km
Continue along this path where the thick forest has now given way to sparser vegetation, with tall bog asphodel plants. The path does a zig-zag, then passes to the right of a covered water tank, before arriving at a junction (point E), about 5 mins after leaving the rocky outcrop. Turn right at this junction and follow the path down to a stile at the main road about 10 mins after the junction. (point F) 15 mins	1 hr 39 mins 3.6 km
Now you start down the other side of the triangle, and your way down to the base of the triangle is a lot easier to find than the way up, as it's well signposted. Turn left on the main road and walk about 50 metres to find the start of the path down, signposted Camí de s'Alzina Fumadora, Fornalutz 45 minutes. Follow this path the whole way down. At its end you turn right onto a concrete road which after 10 metres or so leads you back to the water tank at the base of the triangle (point B). 30 mins	2 hrs 9 mins 4.6 km

Now you have to retrace your steps back to the start. Pass to the right of the water tank, and follow the path round to the right, keeping the wall on your RHS. Cross the road and take the stepped path going down, which leads you back to your starting point in the Plaça d'Espanya. 25 mins.		2 hrs 34 mins 5.1 km
